THE "WHY" - PURPOSE

GOALS

- To Enhance Worship
- Excellence in Worship

PURPOSE

- Honor God
- Prepare for Ministry Opportunities
- Contemporize the Worship Space

- = Greater engagement
- Create an environment conducive to contemplative and joyful worship
- = Attract young people into worship
- = Be relatable to draw those not part of traditional church into a relationship with Jesus

THE "WHAT" - DETAILS

- Redesign Platform Lighting Enhance visibility for in-room audiences and support video streaming. Using the existing electrical system, this update will improve engagement and reduce distractions.
- Add two front corner Screens and Center LED Wall Desire to maintain visibility of stained glass windows, so screens need to be retractable
- Redesign/enlarge existing platform Accommodate PraiseHym (musicians and instruments) during worship. Incorporate altar. Existing music area to become seating.
- Replace pews with chairs
- Update PA (Sound) System

ASSESSMENT

Where are we (Council) at?

Where is the Congregation at?

How Contemporary do we want to be? (Identity) What is God calling us to be?

How do build unity in this matter?

What are the barriers to proceeding? What are people expressing as concerns?

- Pews Memories, "that's my pew" (carved initials!)
- Lighting not a "concert" (Colors? Spotlights? Lower lighting?)
- Putting worship team on the platform (not a performance, not a concert)
- Could we lose our doctrinal stance by doing this
- Upgrade feels like a lot for a small congregation in a small building
- Money -- ~\$300k in total
- Rather invest in 2nd site which could be platform worship team / more modern (but recognize can't ignore the primary residence either...)
- LED screen (feels like overkill, too modern(?))

Are there things we can do to help understand, educate

- Platform Worship in the Courtyard has worship team front and center
- Doctrine we expect this leads to more Biblical worship, not less
- 2nd site the new technology would allow us to prepare for broadcast
- RH side seating (today) -- It's a little unnatural to turn at 45 degree angle to see the screen [and we don't want worship team to be in the lounge... so we like them up front somewhere....]
- This isn't unique in LCMS see other contemporary LCMS churches (King of Kings-Omaha, Hosanna Lutheran-Mankato, Woodbury Lutheran, etc.) *See next slides.
- Worship team on platform goal is to create better engagement, more heart-felt worship
- Many things are perception, or personal preference but are real to the individuals
- LISTEN
- OVERCOMMUNICATE
- Move at a pace which allows us to bring people along

ASSESSMENT


ASSESSMENT
